7. Scholarship funds will only be awarded to the student(s) upon evidence of registration in an accredited post-secondary institution and after the college or university's add/drop period.

Criteria:

1. Applicant must be an active member of Restored Glory Christian Center.
2. Applicant must be a graduating high school senior or enrolled in an accredited post-secondary institution in the year of the scholarship award.
3. Applicant must demonstrate positive-impact involvement – in the complete sense – consistent with capacity and circumstances and/or significant improvement/success in scholarship and community involvement, determined through letters of recommendation.

Application Process:

Applicant must submit the following items:

1. Completed application form (if handwritten, please print legibly)
2. Letter of application addressed to the Scholarship Committee.
3. One (1) letter of recommendations from choice of high school teachers, administrators, counselors, employers, or individual with significant knowledge of applicant's experience and involvement.
4. An official and recent high school transcript with cumulative grade point average and a class standing/rank.
5. Personal Essay. In your essay, please answer the questions of what have you have done to earn this award and what the effect this award will have on your future.
